

MONTE DAS HERDADES

Montes das Herdades is a traditional property located in beautiful Alentejo, the last still unknown paradise in southern Portugal. The vineyards of the variety Malbec, flourish in its sunny and fertile valleys, and are looked after with enthusiasm, dedication and love by the local knowledgeable care takers.

The wine is produced using only the very best grapes from the organic vineyards that grow in the property. The terroir, moonlight harvest and a careful manual selection of the grapes give Monte das Herdades wines a truly unique personality. Here there is no rush, and time is given to the wine to mature to its optimal level before being bottled.



Rosé Malbec 2021

Terroir: Organic vineyard of Monte das Herdades, inserted in 600 hectares of natural reserve surrounded by forest cork oak. Undulating Plain with a great wealth of fauna and flora, which give it a unique character.

Variety: Malbec

Vineyard surface area (older PN): 1 ha

Planting density: 4.000 plants/ha

Harvest: Manual cutting in boxes of 20kg in the middle of August.

Winemaking: Careful reception, with manual selection of clusters and berries. Cold pelicular maceration with controlled low temperature of 10°C. Soft pressing in a pneumatic press.

Maturation: Fermentation in small capacity stainless steel vats, with controlled temperature up to 17°C.

Bottled date: November 2022

Alcohol: 12,5% vol.

Serving temperature: 12°C

Production: 2.024 bottles

Tasting notes: Attractive color, with scents of fruit notes such as ripe cherry, very delicate, with a bouquet of red roses. Elegant palate, with persistent and vibrant acidity, with a fruity finish.
